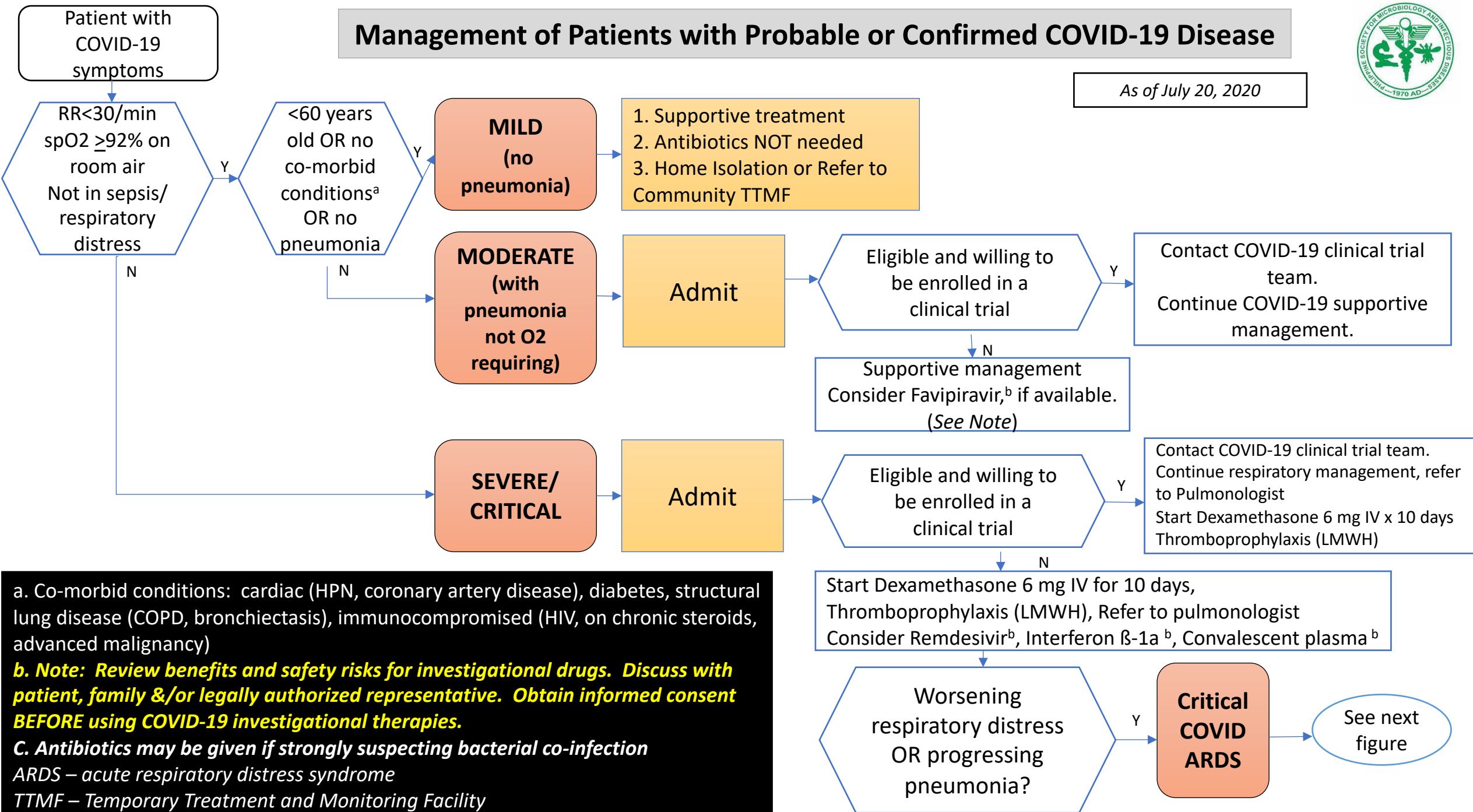
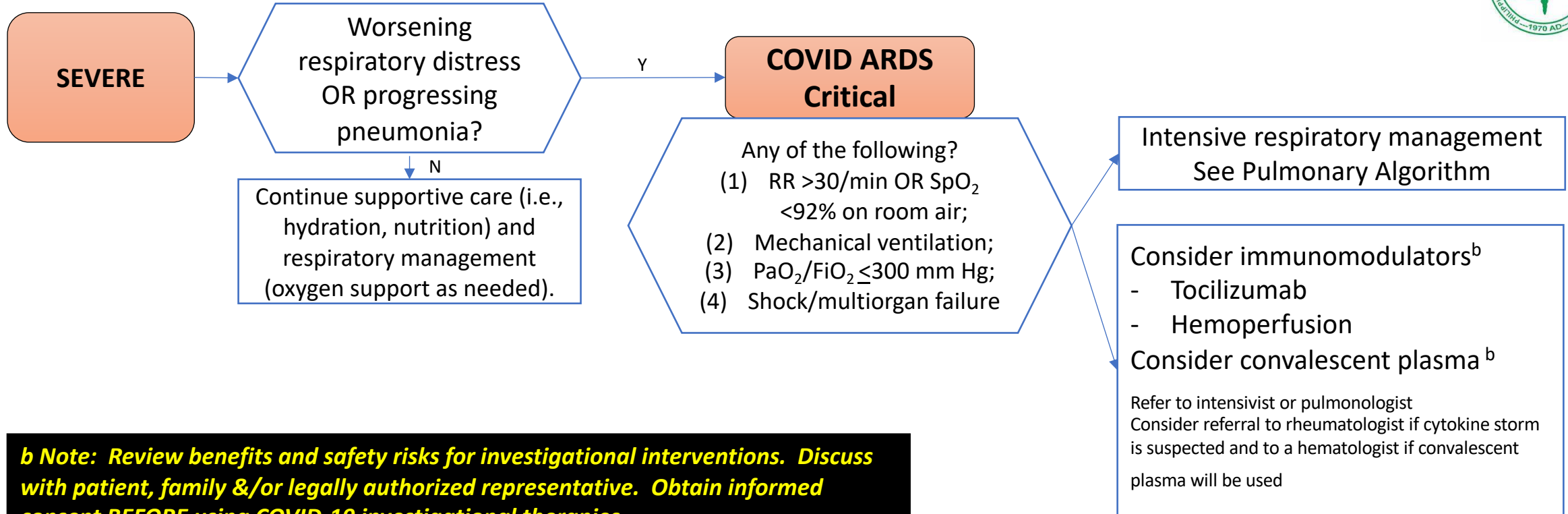

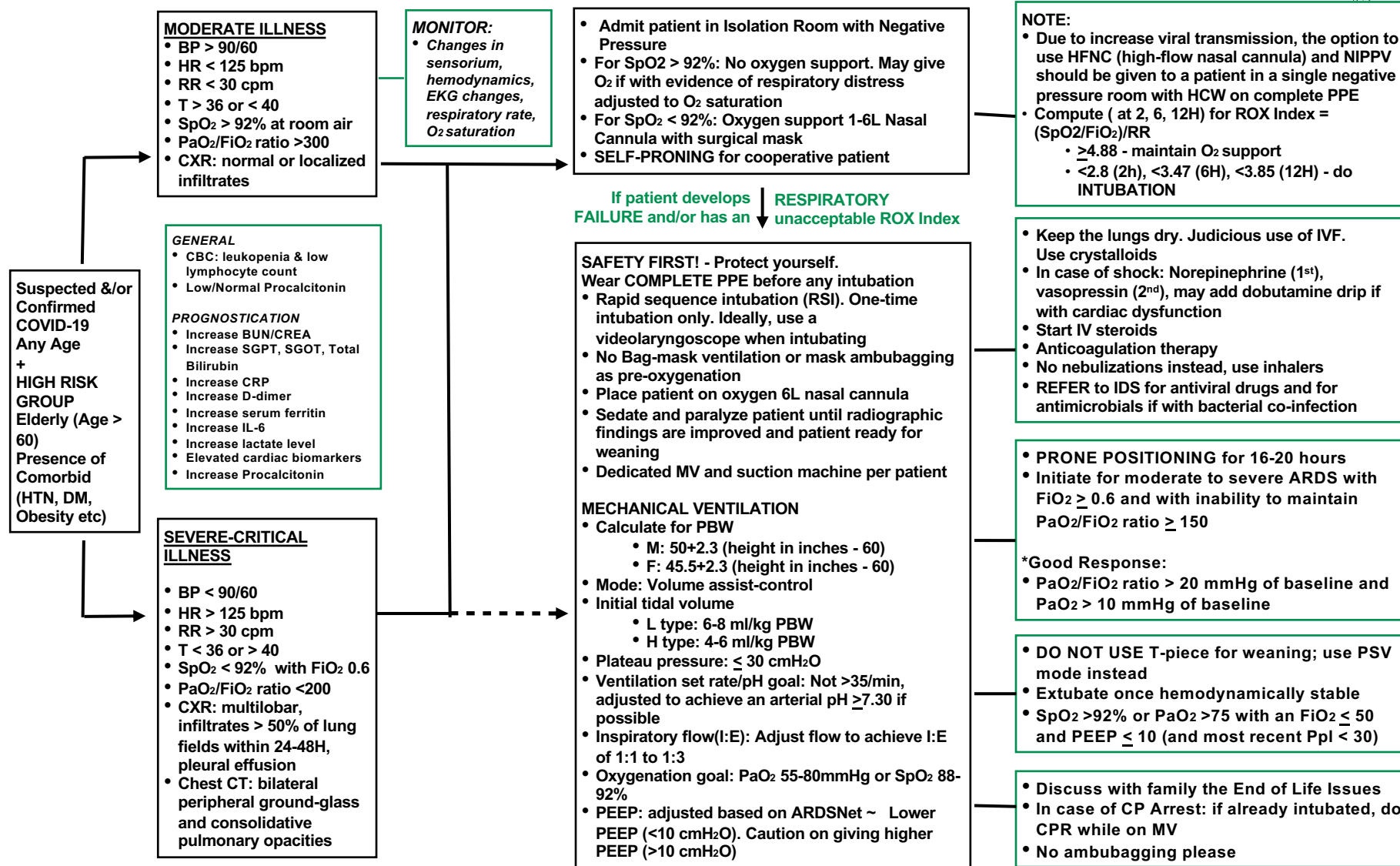

Dosing regimen

Remdesivir	Favipiravir	Dexamethasone	Interferon beta -1a	Tocilizumab
200 mg IV loading dose on Day 1 then 100 mg IV (infused over 30 min) once daily to complete 5-10 days	1,800 mg 2x/day loading dose then 900 mg 2x/day for 13 days	6 mg IV daily for 10 days	Interferon β -1a administered <u>intravenously</u> at the dose of 10 μ g once daily for 6 days OR Interferon β 1a administered <u>subcutaneously</u> at the dose of 44 μ g Day 1, Day 3 and Day 6 (total: 3 doses). It should be given at the same time each day. No dosage adjustment is required for renal or hepatic impairment.	4-8mg/kg single dose with recommended dose of 400mg IV diluted in 0.9 NSS to 100mL, given as a 2-hour infusion A second dose may be given after 12 hours at the discretion of the health care provider
