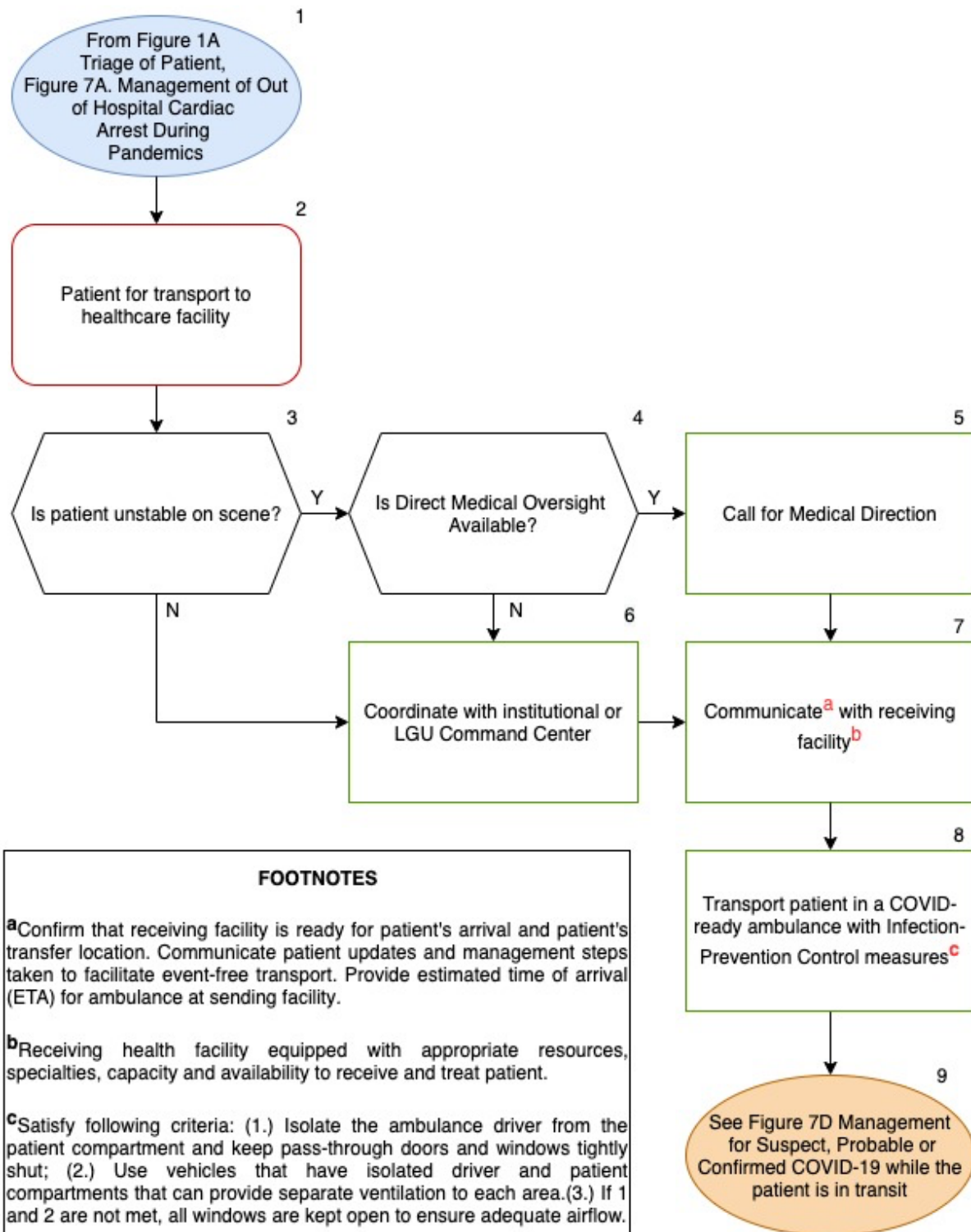


# FIGURE 7B. PRIMARY TRANSPORT\* (PRE-HOSPITAL)

### FOOTNOTES

<sup>a</sup>Confirm that receiving facility is ready for patient's arrival and patient's transfer location. Communicate patient updates and management steps taken to facilitate event-free transport. Provide estimated time of arrival (ETA) for ambulance at sending facility.

<sup>b</sup>Receiving health facility equipped with appropriate resources, specialties, capacity and availability to receive and treat patient.

<sup>c</sup>Satisfy following criteria: (1.) Isolate the ambulance driver from the patient compartment and keep pass-through doors and windows tightly shut; (2.) Use vehicles that have isolated driver and patient compartments that can provide separate ventilation to each area.(3.) If 1 and 2 are not met, all windows are kept open to ensure adequate airflow.

**\*Primary transportation:** Transfer of a patient from the site of an emergency (e.g., public place, residence or workplace) to a healthcare facility.
